## Pile opening OPENING AT THE TOP OF THE CHIMNEY Central stake FROM WHICH THE CONSTRUCTION **OF THE PILE STARTS** Layer of soil ABOUT 10 CM THICK Chimney Layer of leaves 8-10 CM THICK to isolate the charcoal pile, creating an oxygenpoor internal environment,

## Logs

crammed around the central chimney so as to leave no gaps: near the centre are the thicker ones and then, above these, progressively thinner ones.



## Holes

to regulate the amount of oxygen in the charcoal pile and allow the smoke to escape
